Born in Saga on April 18, 1966, on Invention day, Hachiya graduated from the Kyushu Institute of Design (currently Faculty of Design, Kyushu University). He started SMTV, a private TV broadcast station unit, and worked for a consulting firm before founding PetWORKs. His work includes a special communication series represented by "Dis-communication Machine" and "Seeing is Believing" as well as functional equipments such as the jet-powered skateboard "Air Board" and the personal flight system "OPEN SKY." In addition, Hachiya is the developer of the e-mail software PostPet.

Fukuoka-born Manabe is an art director and the momoko creator; she co-founded PetWORKs in 1998. Manabe has managed art direction of the e-mail software PostPet. In 2001, her love of dress-up dolls led her to create the momoko. She continues to present the act of amateur industrial mass production of the dolls as a work of art.

A software architect and programmer by profession, Koki also creates electrical circuit designs and sound.
